horses entered in the show only.

Stabling will be arranged on a first request basis and must be accompanied by an official show entry with payment received in full. No stabling refunds will be provided after the show closing date under any circumstance.

At Blue Star Farm, shavings and hay may be purchased on site. Please ensure to bring your own feed and water buckets as these will not be supplied. Tack stalls will not be available unless booked in combination for the Silver/Bronze show weekend as stabling is limited.

At Rainbow Ridge Ranch, shaving and hay are included in the cost of the stall. As stabling facilities are limited please contact the show organizer directly for confirmation. We recommend that you bring your own buckets or an additional fee will be charged. Payment for stabling should be provided by separate cheque with each entry.
